At the time of building the 2023-2027 strategies, this round table will provide concrete examples of success from several Member States and discuss the levers for simplifying the process in France and in Europe. European funds: an opportunity for rural areas in France and in Europe

European rural agenda, rural pact, multi-fund... In 2021 the European Commission launched a consultation on the long-term vision of rural areas in Europe, while in France the National Strategic Plan for the CAP and the ERDF-ESF Operational Programs 2023-2027 were finalized.

This round table will allow, first, to decipher the stakes of the French Presidency of the Council of the European Union, and then to exchange on the place of rural development and ruralities within European policies, and also the opportunities represented by European funds for rural areas in France and in Europe.

Secondly, the planned contributions of several national and European networks and testimonies from French and European territories, will allow a debate on the challenges of a European rural agenda to ensure that ruralities are taken into account in each European policy. Exchange with the audience.
